**A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE CALIFORNIA
INSTITUTE FOR REGENERATIVE MEDICINE HONORING DR. KEVIN C
EGGAN FOR HIS SERVICE ON THE STANDARDS WORKING GROUP**

WHEREAS, Dr. Kevin Eggan received the MacArthur Foundation “Genius Grant” in 2006, and in 2009, he was selected as one of 50 Howard Hughes Medical Institute Early Career Scientists who will receive six years of dedicated support to conduct transformative research;

WHEREAS, Dr. Eggan has been instrumental in the development of research involving somatic cell nuclear transfer;

WHEREAS, Dr. Kevin Eggan made a unique contribution to CIRM by supporting the development of CIRM’s Medical and Ethical Standards through his service to the Scientific and Medical Accountability Standards Working Group;

WHEREAS, Dr. Eggan continues to make scholarly contributions to the field of regenerative medicine through his current research, which involves the application of stem cell biology to the study of the mechanisms underlying amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS) and the discovery of new therapeutic targets.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the California Institute for Regenerative Medicine recognizes the contributions of Dr. Kevin Eggan to CIRM’s Medical and Ethical Standards Working Group and his broader efforts to support regenerative medicine.
