

# **Funding Runway**


### New awards for 5 years, funding for up to 8 years



- \$2 billion awarded or spent
- \$759 million uncommitted
- \$190-200 million in new awards per year
- Estimated \$20 million in award reductions annually
- Projected NET commitment rate of \$170 million per year



### **The Administrative Bucket**



# At current staffing levels, five more years of funding available

- \$105 million spent
- \$75 million remaining
- Current spend rate of \$15-16 million per year

## **CIRM After 2020: Additional Funds**



- Additional Funding from the State of CA
- Private funding
- Partnerships/Leveraging CIRM funds



### CIRM After 2020: Wind-down

Final grant awards approved 2020



- Final 3 year awards require oversight
- Descending administrative budget
- Agency staffing scales down accordingly
- Philanthropic funds \$30M for up to 4 yrs
- Final pending items transfer to SCO or other control agency
