§ 100120. Record Keeping.

- Each grantee's institution shall maintain records of all CIRM-funded research activities. At
- a minimum, the institution shall maintain a research registry that includes, but is not limited to,
- 4 documentation of:

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- 5 (a) CIRM-funded stem cell research conducted by the institution;
- 6 (b) Any required review or notification requirements as described in Code California
- 7 Regulations, title 17, section 100070;
- 8 (c) The methods utilized to characterize and screen the materials for safety;
- 9 (d) The conditions under which the materials have been maintained and stored;
- 10 (e) Any additional requirements set forth in any other regulations under this title;
- 11 (f) Every gamete, somatic cell, embryo donation or product of SCNT that has been donated,
- created or used. This record should be sufficient to determine the provenance and disposition of
- 13 such materials.
