



## FY 24-25 Major Drivers of Research Budget



#### Interim 6-month Budget

- Supports ARS approvals from July thru December 2024
  - Reopening of Monthly Clinical (CLIN) submissions based on flow control proposal
  - Approvals for 5 programs across 4 pillars
  - Removal of Conference Grant budget to revise RFA in alignment with SAF and tenets of DEI
- December return to the ICOC with a budget for January thru June 2025
  - Estimate adding funds pending SAF recommendations



#### FY 24-25 Financial Considerations



#### Clinical Budget (CLIN) \$145,500

- Number of awards determined by FY 24-25 program goals for 6-month period
- Maximum total award amount
- CLIN1, CLIN2, and CLIN4

#### Translational Budget (TRAN) \$60,000

- Average number of awards in FY 23-24
- Average award amount in FY 23-24

- DISC4 ReMIND-L: \$88,200, 6 awards
