25	IT WILL BE JUNE THE 5TH TO JUNE THE 16TH. SO THAT

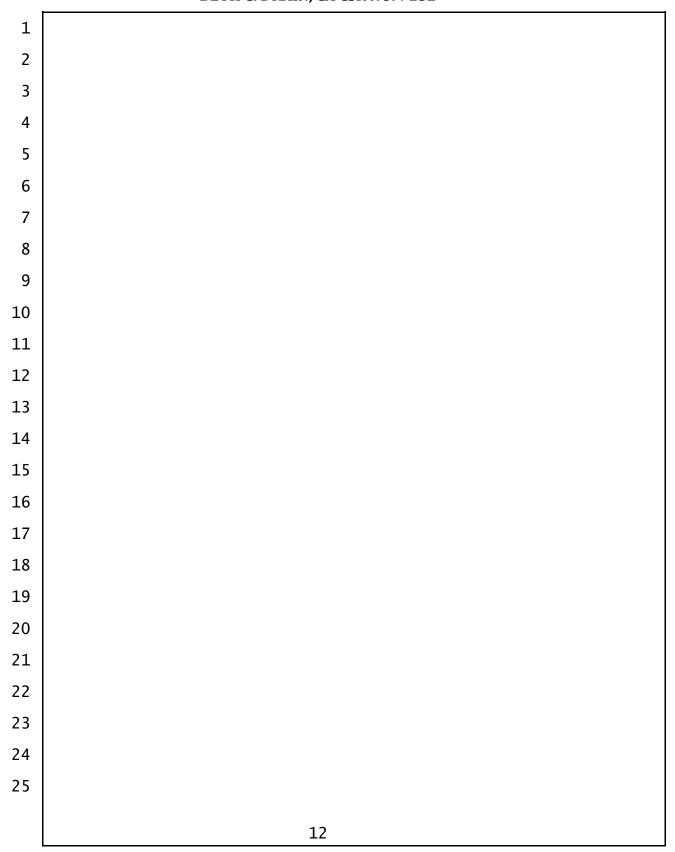
